General description of research activities:

Basic research: Molecular biology and ultrastructure, e.g. receptor studies in keratinocytes, Langerhans cells, melanocytes and leukocytes derived from tissue cultures, healthy individuals or patients with inflammatory and hyperproliferative dermatoses and wound healing. His team used the quantitative real-time RT-PCR methodology to show marker expression on circulating melanoma cells in patients with malignant melanoma. His experimental and clinical research is linked also to the evaluation of nanotechnologies in wound healing.

In the clinical research he took part in a number of multinational and multicenter trials phase II + III concerning new drug development in psoriasis, atopic eczema, acne, herpes zoster, melanoma and chronic wounds.
