He is a Medicine Doctor, holds a Diploma in Hospital Management and after being the general manager for several hospitals was the Spanish development Coordinator for Health Cooperation for the Government of Costa Rica. Later was nominated as General Secretary (1988-90) of the Andalusia Regional Health Service in Spain.

He became the President and CEO of Sadiel, S.A. for the period 1990-97, and afterward he started as Business Area Director for Shared Medical System Corp. (SMS). He was also appointed as Member of the Consultation Group to the Director General of the WHO for TELEMEDICINE (Geneva, 1997). He is the former President of the EUROREC INSTITUTE (2002-2004), the European Institute for the Electronic Health Record. After directing his own consultancy company Consultores Euroamericanos Asociados (2001-2012), he is back on the public health system as specialist at the Osuna Hospital in Sevilla.

He has been as well the Conference Chairman and organiser of the Open Source World Conference, OSWC, for 2004, 2005, 2006, 2008, 2010 and 2012.

In 2006 he was the Conference Chairman of the eHealth High Level Ministerial Conference organised by the European Commission. He has coordinated the two "ICT and Disabilities Reports" published by the Vodafone Foundation (2003 and 2005). Also he was responsible for the "Health and ICT in the developing countries" a report for the European Parliament as well as co-author of the study: "The Potential of ICT in Supporting Domiciliary Care in Spain" for the IPTS, DGJRC, European Commission.

He is active as Lecturer and publisher of many articles on e-Health, Information Society and lately on issues related to e-Inclusion, active ageing and independent living. Regularly Juan acts as expert and reviewer for evaluation of projects at European, national and regional level.
